Dr. Shami Performs an Innovative Acid Reflux Procedure



Transoral incisionless fundoplication (TIF) refers to a surgical solution that corrects the root cause of gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD). GERD—also known as acid reflux disease—is the cause of an anatomic defect at the gastroesophageal valve (GEV). Visual guidance from an endoscope is required to place the EsophyX device

used to reconstruct the GEV. TIF is an incisionless technique where the surgeon performs the work on the inside of the body. Done under general anesthesia in a hospital setting, it is performed as a same-day procedure unlike the surgical procedures from the past, which required two to three days of hospital time.
